



Surveyed on the thirty first day of October 1733 To Jacob Funka Tract of Land situate in the Township of Salford in the County of Philada. Beginning at a post in the line of Francis Vandevill land thence by the same North East one hundred & Nine perches to a post in the line of Francis Daniel Pastorius's land thence by the same South East two hundred & Twenty perches to a Black Oak thence by Land late of James Steel's South West one hundred & Nine perches to a Black Oak thence by Vacant Land North West two hundred & Twenty perches to the Place of Beginning Containing one hundred and forty one Acres with the usual Allowance -
 By Warrant dated the 9th of March 1733
 Surveyed the 11th of the afores^d 1733
 Returned into the Secretary's Office the 15th of the 30th mo 1734.
