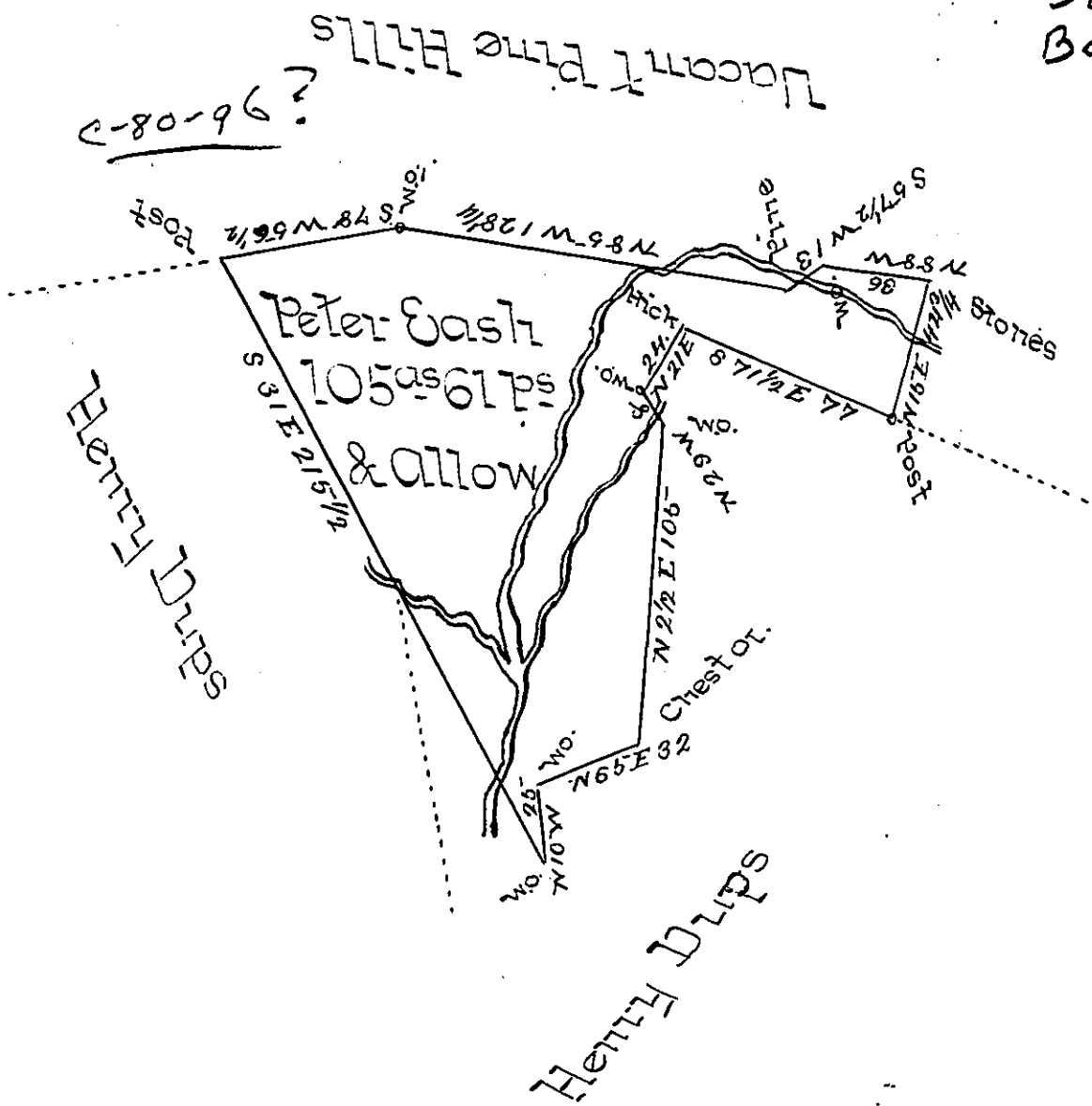

Which appears to have been Surveyed the 15th Day of November 1793 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Peter Eash Dated Feb^y. 3rd 1755 The Original of which has been Delivered over to me by my Predecessor Sam^l Lyon Esq^r as an Office paper the survey must have been Executed Under the Direction of Sam^l Lyon Esq^r who was the Deputy Surveyor of the District at the Date of the Survey -
