



In pursuance of a Special Warrant of Resurvey of the 28th of February 1763 for Rectifying some errors in the Survey of a Tract of Land called 236^a in Coccoloc Township Lancaster County which was granted by Patent to Isaac Weidner dated 11th of May 1750 [on a Vacated Warrant of the 18th of February 1745 To John Cool & of a Warrant of the 24th of March 1749 To said Isaac Weidner] I did on the 16th day of June 1763 Resurvey for George Hack et the above Described Tract of Land called 236^a according to the lines of the Contiguous Tracts and find the same to contain 30¹/₄ with the Allowance of six Percent.
