



The small piece described by the Frick's Wines at A contains a field & improvement of James McKissock's which I thought not proper to include in this Survey, as the sd McKissock had applied to the Office for the Purchase thereof, before the Location Order was granted to Andrew Gibson, who did not obtain a warrant because the Office was shut.

The above Survey was made for Andrew Gibson the 16th Anno 1765. Pursuance of an order, endorsed on the back of a former Warrant which was granted for land in another Township but not executed, therefore order'd to be located here. Tho' thro' an error in the said order the Township is call'd East Nottingham what the land lies in Oxford Township in the County of Chester.
