The above is part of a tract which was surveyed the 10th day of February 1813 in pursuance of a Warrant granted to William Wilson dated April 13th 1773 it was then said to contain 154 Acres 22 perches & allowance &c this part resurveyed & divided from the residue of said tract 23rd March 1822
