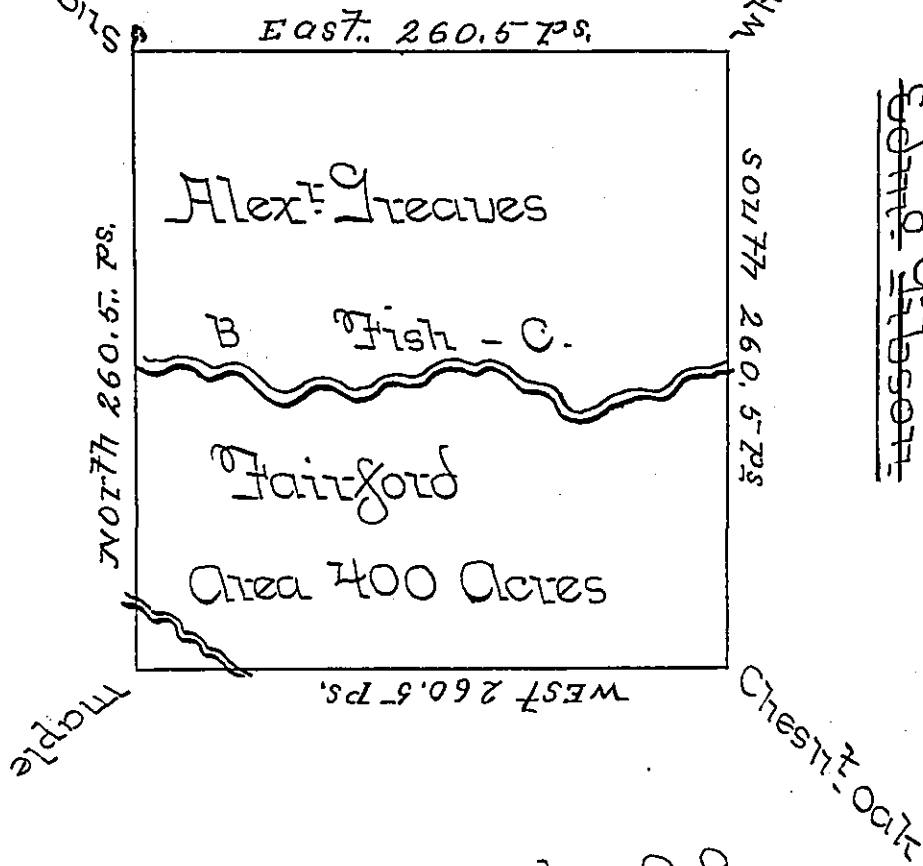


Bull Run Tree Bed
