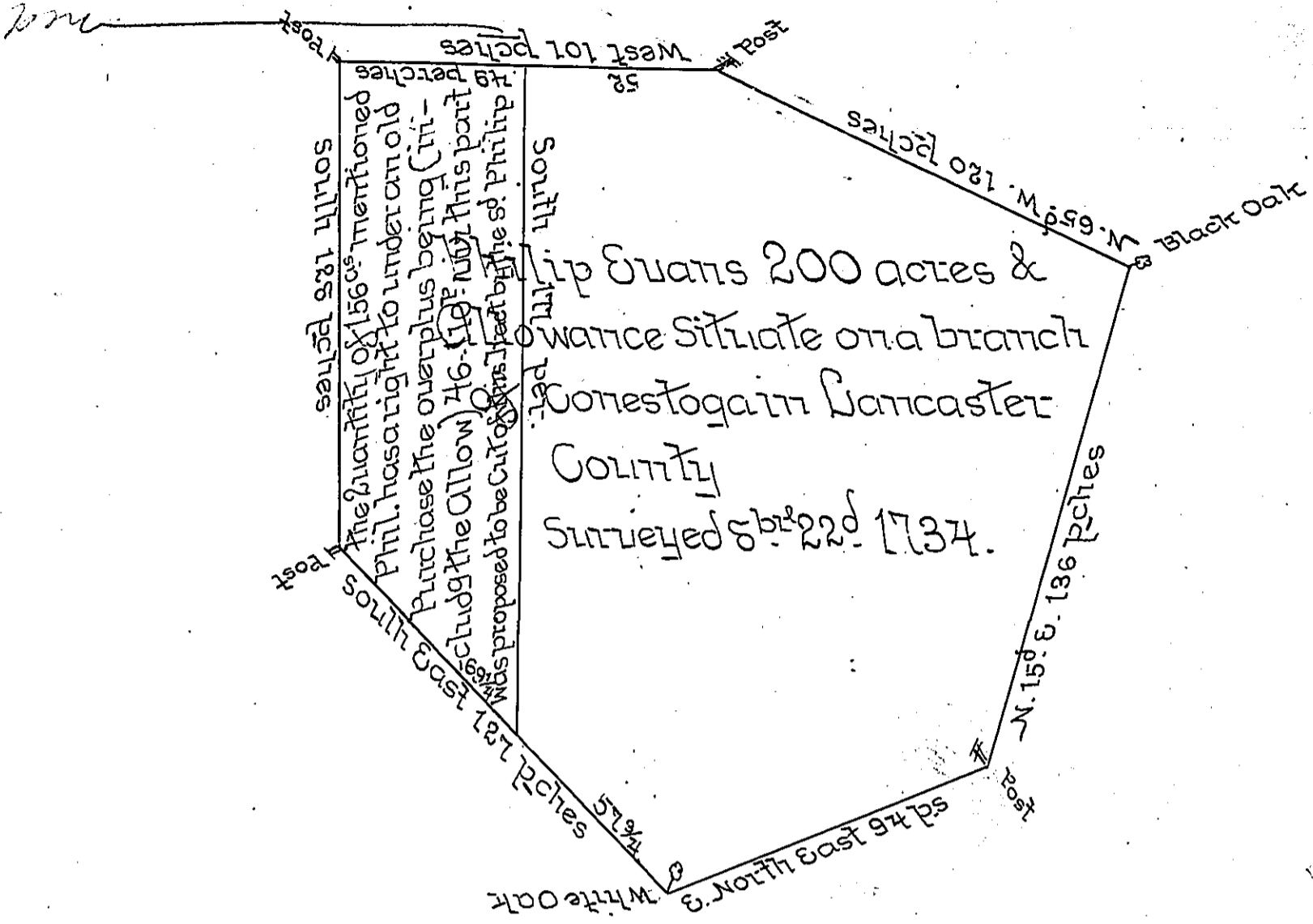



One Hundred & fifty six acres of the above Tract was Surveyed to Philip Evans by Warrant from the Proprietors of 20th June 1733, and the residue by Verbal order ~

David & Philip Evans had a Warrant from the Proprietors for 312<sup>ac</sup> on the 20th of June 1733 of which Quantity each has a right to 156 acres & David had a Tract of 4<sup>ac</sup> Quantity Surveyed 10th of October 1737
