



Resurveyed the first day of September A.D. 1852 at the request of George Shadle, letter A is a part of what is called Manor of Spread Eagle land containing thirty five acres & fifty perches and allowance of 6 percent &c and B is the same which was surveyed unto Henry Shadle in pursuance of a warrant dated the 11th day of April 1517 surveyed the 20th day of May 1517 by Jacob Rockefeller D.S. The above draught represents the original courses & distances as near as it could be ascertained situate partly in Schuylkill and partly in Northumberland County containing one hundred and thirty eight acres one hundred and forty four perches & allowance &c.
