



By Virtue of a Warrant dated 17<sup>th</sup> August 1793 Surveyed 5<sup>th</sup> September 1793 to William Maybury the above tract of land situate in Luzerne County and on the branches of a small stream that empties on the East Side of the North East Branch of the River Susquehanna about two miles & a half below the state line & about a mile above Tioga Point and containing four hundred and thirty three Acres and one hundred & fifty four perches and allowance of six Percent for Roads &c
