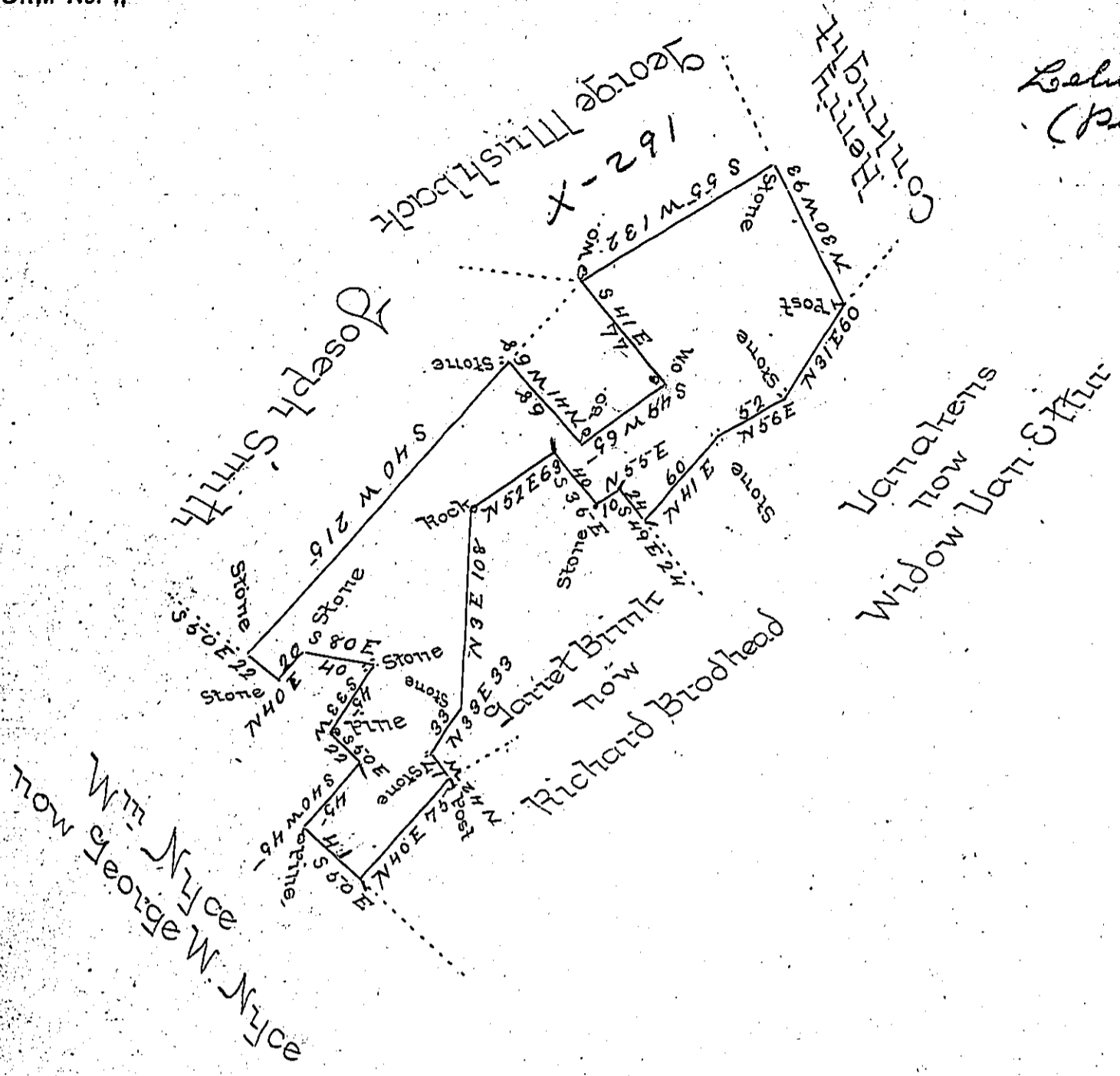


Lehman

 Surveyed 19<sup>th</sup> day of May 1816. To Patience Seely the above
