



Situated on both sides of <sup>the</sup> State Road leading from Bedford to Pittsburgh and on the Waters of Luema honing Creek in Luema honing Township Bedford County and surveyed the 20<sup>th</sup> day of July 1787. In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the first day of November 1786.

Note this Warrant was taken for a Tract of Land on both side of little Coughwick Creek in Dublin Township, but could not be laid on the Ground mentioned in the Warrant by reason of a prior Warrant in the name of Hugh Cowan dated the — day of —
