



By Virtue of a Warrant dated March 15th 1793 order of Survey received September 15th 1845 Surveyed September 16th 1845 to Moses Brink the above described Tract of Land situate in Dingman Township (formerly Northampton) now Pike County adjoining lands (formerly surveyed to Able James) now Chas and Alexander Stedman including the Road from Delaware to Wyoming and a Branch of Rattle Snake Creek containing three hundred and thirty Acres & fifty two Perches and allowance of six P^{er} C^{ent} for Roads &c -
