

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 20th day of May Anno Dom 1740 the above Described Lands were Laid out unto John Davis and Thomas Jones in the County of Lancaster and Township of Heidelberg &c. (Including a Survey Formerly made for Griffith Hughes &c.) viz To John Davis 160^a beside y^e usual allowance & To Thomas Jones 133¹/₂ beside allowance. Surveyed the 26th of y^e 1st mo^o 1741.

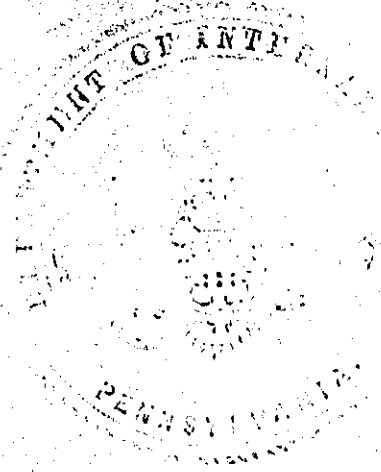
The Warrant afores^d being for 300^{ac} was granted to John Davis & in Pursu. thereof both Tracts in one description were Returned to y^e 16th of June 1741 in order to be Confirmed to him by patent - John Davis agrees to grant to Tho. Jones 133¹/₂ a. Allon. as above divided for a proportional part of the purchase money &c.

June 17th 1741 Rec^d of John Davis --- £1.3 for S. Lightfoot
