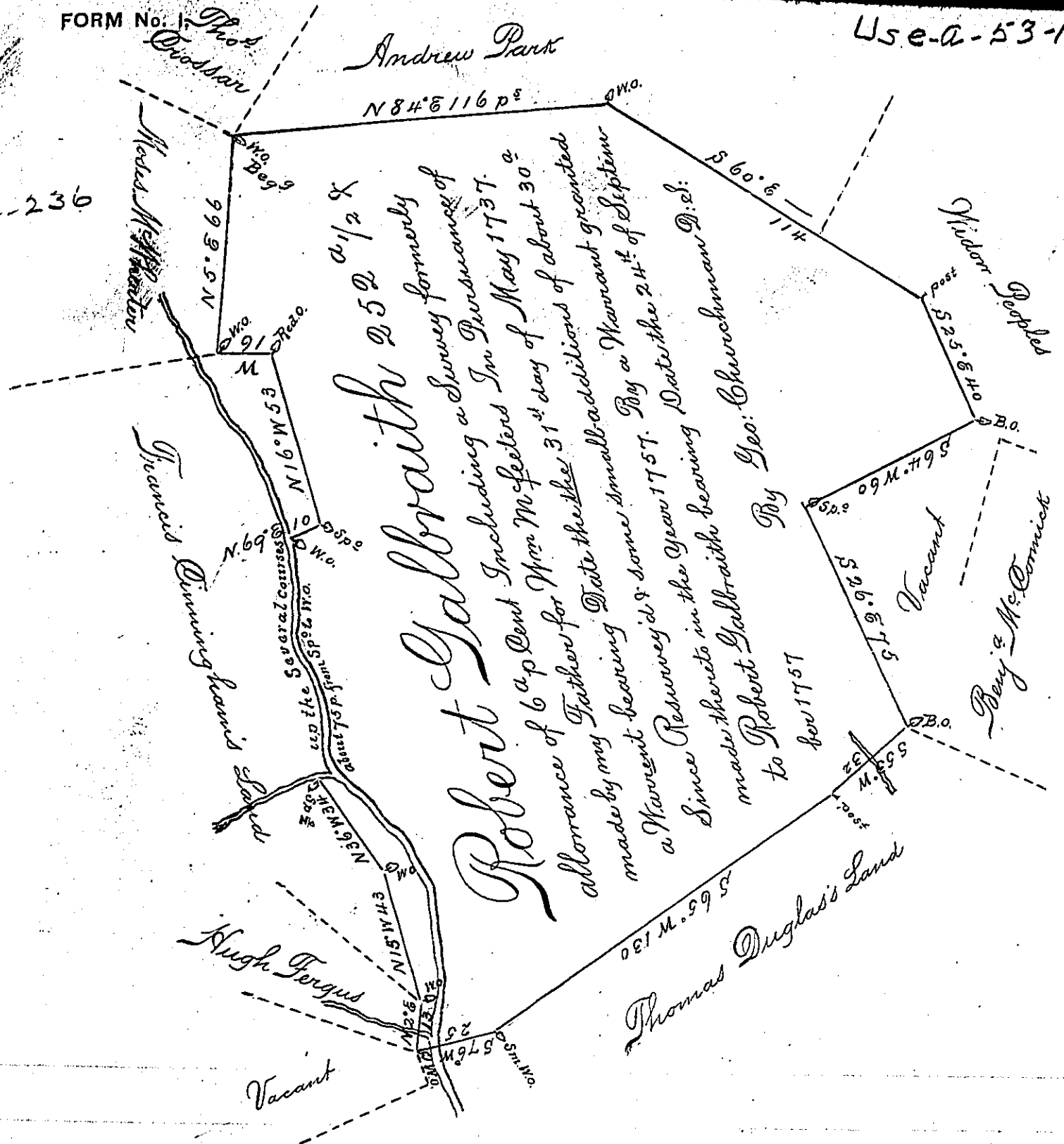

In Pursuance of a Survey formerly made by my Father for Wm McFeters In Pursuance of a Warrant of 6 a p Ent Including In Pursuance of May 1757 & made by me the 31st day of about 30 made by my Father Date the 24th of September a Warrant bearing Date the 24th of September Since Resurvey'd & some small additions granted to Robert Gallbraith bearing Date the 24th of September in the Year 1757. By a Warrant granted by Geo: Churchman D:cl: to Robert Gallbraith bearing Date the 24th of September 1757

Note that from the Corner Spanish Oak at Z it runs down a small Branch to a larger Stream descending into Octoraro Creek, & thence up the several Courses of the said Stream to a White oak on the East side thereof: The Land lies on the Branches of Octoraro Creek in Colerain Township Lancaster Co^{ty}

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this *fourth* day of *April* 189*9*.
