



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the twenty sixth day of October 1734 Surveyed unto Christian Getzenbeamer a tract of Land Situate in Frederick Township in the County of Phildel^a. Beginning at a Large W^o Oak in a line of Jacob Hildbraugh's Land thence by land of Hans Swer North West fifty perches and by land of George Herger the same course fortyfour perches to a post thence by land of George Haver North East one hundred and eightytwo perches to a White Oak thence by Vac^t Land South East ninetyfour perches to a post thence by Vac^t Land, Land of John Harp and Land of Jacob Hildbraugh South West one hundred and eightytwo perches to y^e place of Beginning Containing one Hundred acres with the usual allowance of six sp. Cents
