



Situate on the waters of Loyalsock Creek in Muncy Township Northumberland County, now Lycoming, surveyed on the 9 day of October 1793 for Daniel Hedden by virtue of a warrant bearing date on the 3<sup>rd</sup> Day of September 1792, containing Four Hundred & forty four acres of the usual allowance of six percent of taken from the Field notes of Joseph J. Wallis then Deputy Surveyor.
