And contains a part of a survey made for Henry Beeson by order of survey No 3455 which survey was formerly returned into the Surveyor General's Office, but the said Henry Beeson having sold the part above described to William Campbell & the residue to Jacob Beeson, & they desiring to have separate patents I resurveyed the same agreeable to their purchases — And the said William Campbell having taken up and settled a piece of land adjacent thereto, & desiring to include the whole in one patent I have included his claim distinguishing the quantities held under each right viz. Location No 3455, dated 14th June 1769. And a warrant dated the 6th day of November 1789.
