



The above described Draught distinguished by the letter O marked on each line represents a tract of land situate in Southampton Township Franklin County (formerly Hopewell Township Lancaster County) Surveyed 29th September 1743. on warrant to Thomas Edmeston dated 18th July 1743 & returned to the Land Office containing by said survey 233¹/₂ acres of all. The two figures embracing A & B. containing 116.58 appears to have been Surveyed 21 July 1787 for George Johnston on the warrant to Thos. Edmeston above mentioned & also returned to the Land Office. The two figures embracing C & D. appears to have been surveyed for Benjamin Johnston on his warrant dated 17th May 1786 & returned. The Figure marked E of the original tract is included with the Figure F and Survey 18 October 1787 on Warrant to James Fall dated 1st of September 1787. Ascertained by actual survey 24 November 1828 under contract for the Commonwealth.
