



By Warrant from the Proprietaries of the 16th of January 1733. Survey'd unto Samuel Fenney the 23^d of the same Month a Tract of Land on Kookosing Creek in the County of Lancaster Beginning at a post in a line of Edw. J. Fenney's land thence South East by the same & vacant Land 213 pches to a Hickery, thence South West by Vacant Land 120 pches to a Black Oak, thence North West by Vacant Land 213 pches to a Black Oak, thence North East 120 pches to the place of Beginning, Containing One hundred and fifty acres and the usual allowance for Roads,
