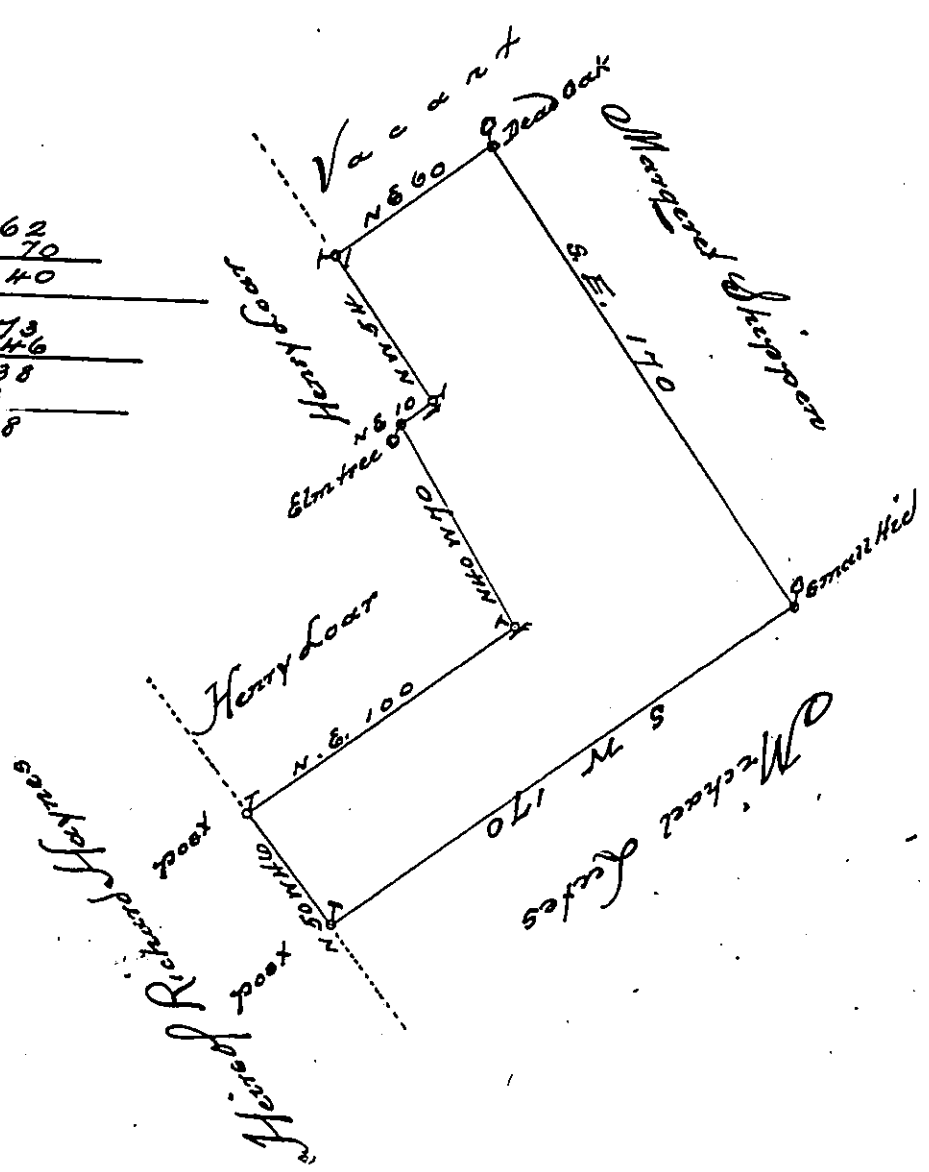

Warrant dated the 5th of Feb 1733

Surveyed on the thirteenth day of June 1734 To Ulrich Englehart a Tract of land situate in New-comissokoppin in the County of Philad<sup>a</sup>. Beginning at a Dead Oak a corner of Margeret Shippen's land thence by the same South East one hundred and seventy perches to a Small Hickory sapling. Being a corner of Michael Lutes land thence by the same South West one hundred and seventy perches to a post on the line of a Tract of Land belonging to y<sup>e</sup> Heirs of Richard Haynes Dece'd. thence by y<sup>e</sup> same North fifty degrees West forty six perches to a post thence by land of Henry Loar North East one hundred perches to a post. thence by y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Henry Loar's Land North forty degrees West seventy perches to an Elm tree thence by y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Loar's Land North East ten perches to a post. thence by y<sup>e</sup> same Land North West fifty four perches to a post thence by Vacant Land North East sixty perches to y<sup>e</sup> place of Beginning Containing ninety six acres with usual allowance
