



A Draught of an Island situate in the River Susquehanna, Manor Township, Lancaster County opposite the place called Murphy's Horner on the York Shore, about one hundred perches to the Northward of Patience Wright's garden Island and about the same distance to the Eastward of Michael Meisters Island. Commonly known by the name of Grape Island. Containing ninety perches strict measured. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 23<sup>rd</sup> of October 1810. Granted to Peter Snawder.
