



Situate in York Township in the County of York, and containing as above set forth 22° 90 1/2' allowance. Being part of a larger tract of land originally surveyed by William Matthews late D.S. on the 10th day of August 1770, in pursuance of an Application No. 5584, dated the 28th day of August 1769 granted to Jacob Stronman for 150^a. Resurveyed and divided off from the said larger tract on the 20th of April 1797, by John Forsyth late D.S. And now after having been carefully examined corrected and calculated, it is at the request of the present owner Peter Diehl, returned for Confirmation the 2th day of August A.D. 1809.
