



A Draught of a Tract of land called Quakers purchase situate on the Waters of Taunkicoke Creek on the southerly side of the North East Branch of the River Duqueshanna in the County of Northumberland containing three hundred and twenty four acres and a half besides the usual allowance of six per cent for roads &c &c surveyed the first day of August 1774 for John Shaw in pursuance of a Warrant dated 19th August 1775.
