Situated joining Doctor Morgan's Land below the <sup>(old)</sup> Harrisburg old Town and North of the old Indian Path in Henryfield Township Westmoreland County and surveyed the 13th of Nov: 1776. In pursuance of a Warrant Dated the 1st day of July 1776.
