



In pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the 4th of April last Resurvey'd to Henry Carpenter a Tract of Land in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a Poplar Tree, being a corner of Henry Nain's Land thence West by South by the same two hundred sixty five pches & a half to a post, thence North by West by the Land of Christopher Francis one Hundred and twelve pches & a half to a post thence East by North by the same Land thirty four pches to a post, thence North by West by the Land of the s^d Christopher Francis one Hundred & twelve pches & a half to a Small Hickory, thence East by North by the Land of John Weaver two Hundred thirty one pches & a half to a post thence South by East by the Land of David Longacre two Hundred and twenty five pches to the Beginning* Containing three Hundred and forty nine acres
