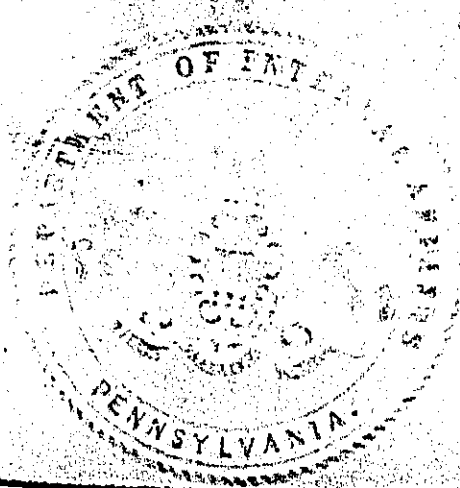


The above is a Draught of a Survey made May the 20th 1794 in pursuance of a warrant granted to Ebenezer Denny Dated the 10th day of Feby 1794 Situate where the Venango Path crosses the first Large stream that enters into Big Beaver on the North side of said Stream and about 18 miles from Pittsburgh North and West of the River Ohio in District No 9 Containing four hundred thirty nine acres and thirty four poles together with the usual allowance of six per Cent for Roads Called Ritch Hill
