



Situate on the north side of the Youghiogenei River, in Tyrone township, Fayette County, & resurveyed the 23<sup>d</sup> June 1822 in pursuance of an order of the Board of Property for excluding the Island & dated the 25<sup>th</sup> day of Feb'y 1822. the Warrant of Moorcraft is dated the 17 Dec<sup>r</sup> 1787.

The above is a corrected draft of the resurvey referred to, filed in my office as it was made by Alex<sup>r</sup> McClean formerly deputy, and is, in its boundaries, agreeable to the adjoining Surveys. the old Survey of Moorcraft made a small interference with the J. Walters at the place marked A but Walters being the oldest right the small triangle is thrown off to his survey; the lines <sup>running nearer the water</sup> by the river, in the resurvey, than in the former one, under the line East 69 instead of 64 p<sup>t</sup>.
