



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 17th Day of October. Anno Dom. 1737 The above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto John Jones in Robinson Township in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a Post in the Line of Rees Prichard Thence South 55 Degrees East by Vacant Land 161 perches to a Black Oak Thence North 35 Degrees East by Vacant Land 158 perches to a Post Thence North 55 Degrees West by Vacant Land 161 perches to a small Black Oak Thence South 35 Degrees West by Vacant Land and the Land of Rees Prichard 158 perches to the place of Beginning Containing One Hundred and fifty Acres beside of allowance of six p Cent for Roads
