



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries Dated the ten fifth day of February 1733 Surveyed unto John Fisher a tract of Land situated in Oley in the County of Philadelphia Beginning at a Hickery a corner of John Turks land thence by the same North East Seventy Seven perches to a post thence by land of Peter Bailey South East one hundred sixty two perches to a White Oak thence by land of David Coffman South West sixty two perches to a Hickery thence South East by said Coffman twenty four perches to a post thence by s<sup>d</sup> Coffman South West twenty four perches and by Vacant land twenty seven perches to a post thence by Vacant land North West one hundred sixteen perches to a post thence by land of Samuel Gulden North East thirty six perches to a Hickery thence by s<sup>d</sup> Gulden's land North West seventy perches to the place of Beginning Containing one hundred acres with the usual Allowance of six p Cent Surveyed Feb<sup>r</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> 1734
