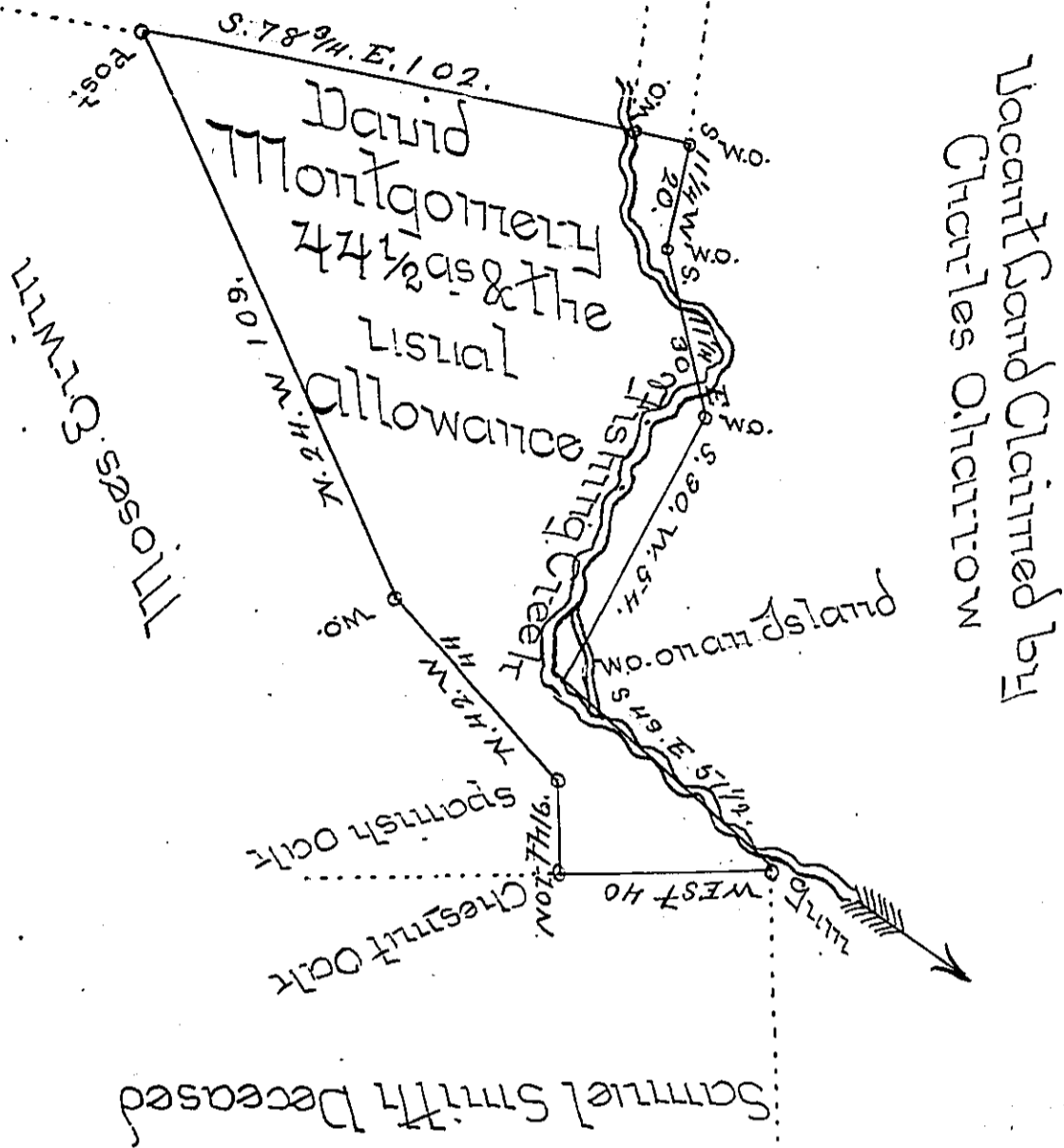


John Balls old survey



A Draught of a Tract of Land Situate in Drumore Township in the County of Lancaster, Containing forty four Acres and one half of an Acre and the usual Allowance of Six Cent for Roads Surveyed, in pursuance of a Warrant bearing date the 3rd day of February A.D. 1743. Granted to David Montgomery Surveyed by John Churchman the 12th of February A.D. 1744 &c. Taken from his Draught Remaining in my Office August the 31st A.D. 1809
