

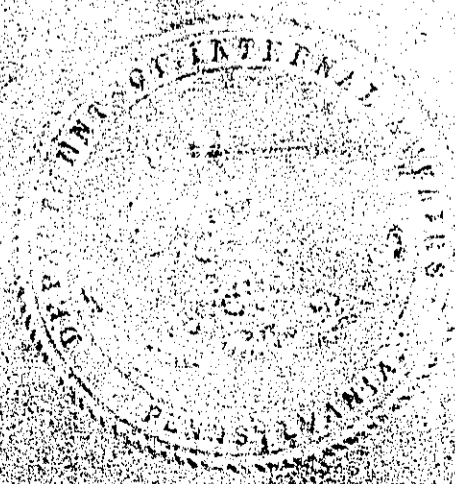
By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor Dated the 25<sup>th</sup> of ye 11<sup>th</sup> Month Anno Dom 1737 The Above Described Tract of Land was Surveyed unto Herman Lenn in ~~locality~~ Earle Township & ye County of Lancaster Beginning at a Black Oak in the line of Henry Miller Thence North 15 Degrees West &c. Containing Two Hundred & seven Acres beside ye allowance of Six Percent
