



The tract described by this Draught was Survey'd the 7<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> Mo. March 1750. In Partnership between John Ramsey & John Grinn (In pursuance of a warrant in the name of Jno Carvin (which I suppose was wrong spelled) bearing date the 30<sup>th</sup> January preceding, is situated in Martick Township Lancaster Co. & I believe the right thereof was afterwards vested in John Ramsey alone,
