



A Draught of an Island situate in the River Susquehanna in the Town-  
 ship of Donegal in the County of Lancaster. Called Upper Brushy Island,  
 at the head of Chesnut Riffles, opposite lands of Michael Breneman  
 on the East Shore, And opposite lands of Henry B. Spruce on the West  
 shore, and an East course from Bald Eagle Island. Containing one  
 hundred & three perches, strict measure. Surveyed in pursuance of a  
 warrant dated the 10th day of August Anno Domini 1821. granted to  
 Peter Desenberg.
