



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 18<sup>th</sup> of March 1793. granted to Joshua Seely and Order of resurvey dated April 12<sup>th</sup> 1850 granted on petition of Levi Mearns surveyed the 13<sup>th</sup> of May 1850 the above described tract of Land Situate in (formerly Upper Smithfield) now Westfall Township Pike County, adjoining lands of Cornelius Dewitt James Vanauken and Peter Quick. Containing three hundred and ninety six acres one hundred and thirty four perches and the allowance of six per Cent for Roads &c.
