


Pilot Island Survey

A Draught of an Island situated in the River Susquehanna, in Manor Township Lancaster Called Pilot Island, lying about one mile south east from Christian Wissler's Warehouse, about a mile from the York Shore and about three quarters of a mile south east from said Wissler's Island Containing two perches strict measure. Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated 2nd day of January Anno Dom. 1821, granted to Henry Eshleman
Examined & Certified 3rd of May 1830.
