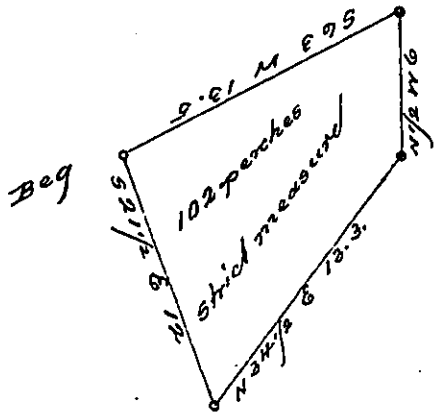


York County Shore

Called Rockstream Island about three quarters of a mile from the Lancaster County shore, and at the foot of Starrs Ripples, containing one hundred and two perches strict measure, Surveyed in pursuance of a warrant dated the 12th day of ⁺May Anno Domini 1821. granted to William English, who transferred the same to
