



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate in Chanceford Township in the County of York (late of the County of Lancaster) Survey'd for David Jones the 13th day of March 1744/5. by Thomas Cookson late D.S. of Lanc^r. County, in pursuance of a warrant bearing date the 15th day of March 1743. The lines examined & a small corner of Barren Land left out, at the instance of David Jones, Son of the above named David Jones, the 16th day of April, 1760. and containing, as it now stands, one hundred & sixty seven Acres, and the allowance of six acres of Cent. for Roads & Highways.
