



Divided off on the 28<sup>th</sup> day of March 1806 for John Stark (agreeable to the Old Lines) The above described tract containing twenty acres & ninety-five perches & allowance situate in Heidelberg Township (late as Lancaster now) Dauphin County, being part of a larger Tract of 86<sup>1/2</sup> barrow<sup>a</sup> granted to Bernard Dohler by Warrant of the 2<sup>d</sup> day of September 1742.
