



By Virtue of a Warrant Dated the 2nd Day of September Anno Domini 1742. The above described Tract of Land was surveyed to Bernard Stoler in Lebanon Township and Lancaster County, Beginning at a White Oak at Corner of Theobald Paff's Land, Thence North East by North by No. 24 perches to a White Oak. Thence South East by East, by Sr. Paff 25 per. to a small Hickory &c. Containing Eighty six acres, beside the usual Allowance of six sq. Clerk.
