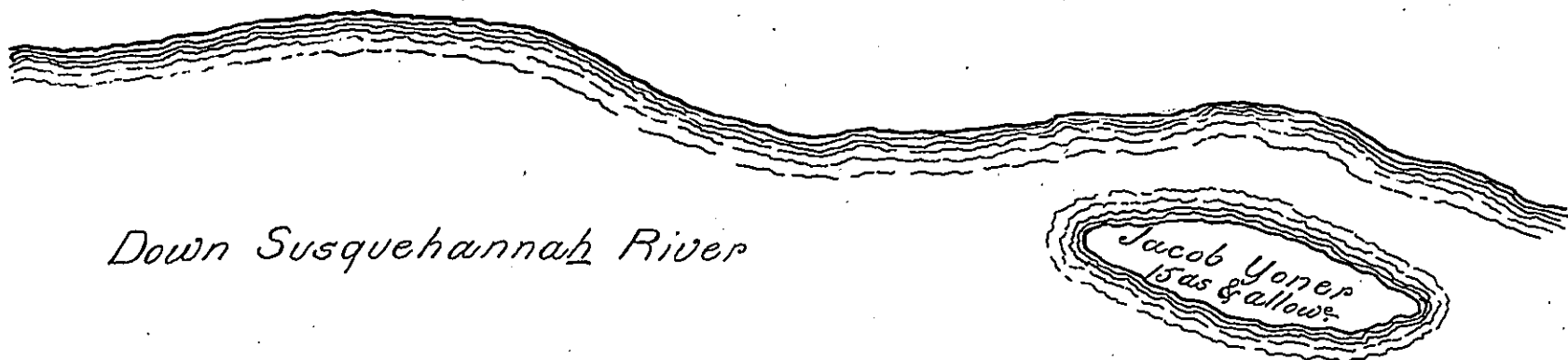
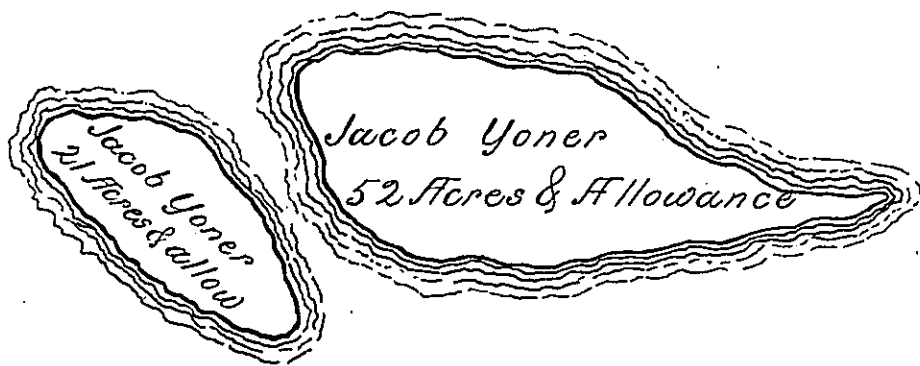

By Virtue of two Warrants from the Proprietaries, one of them granted to the said Jacob Yoner bearing Date the 12th Day of the Month called November Anno Dom 1760. The other granted to the Legatees of Nehemiah Allen bearing Date the 11th Day of the 12th Month 1701 the three Islands above described were Surveyed to the said Jacob Yoner. Situate between the Township of Donegall in Lancaster County and the Township of Manchester in York County and between Conewaga Falls and the mouth of Codorus Creek. The lowermost was Surveyed the 22nd and the two uppermost the 24th Days of the 11th Month 1760.
