



In Pursuance of an order from the Commissioner of Property bearing date the 16th day of June 1772 a Survey was made on the 3d. day of July following on a Certain Lot of Ground Situate in the Town of Sunbury in the County of Northumb. marked in a General Plan of said Town Number Seventeen. Containing in Breadth East and West on the Square Sixty feet, and in Length North and South One hundred and Seventy feet, Bounded Northward by the Square aforesaid, Eastward by Lot Number Twenty, Southward by Barberry Alley, and Westward by Lot Number Sixteen. Returned into the Secretary's office the 29th. day of December 1774 for James Lewis Senr by Wt. of the same day.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this seventh day of November 1899
