



In Pursuance of a Warrant dated the 14th day of April 1774 I did on the 12th day of May 1774 Survey and lay out for George Forepaugh a Certain Lot of Ground Situate at or near the North End of the City of Philada. and without the limits thereof marked in a General Plan of the Lots at Callowhill Number Seventy containing in Breadth East and West on the North Side of Callowhill Street Twenty feet and in Length North and South one hundred feet Bounded Southward by Callowhill Street aforesaid, Westward part by the Center Square and part by Lot Number Sixty Nine, Northward by Lot Number Seventy One & Eastward by Lot Number Seventy three
