



Survey'd the above described tract of land for William Antis on the 17th. day of February 1815 containing Three hundred and five acres forty three perches & allowance of 6 pr. Ct. - In pursuance of his warrant dated the 29th. of Sept. 1814 - Situate in Wayne Township Lycoming County and bounded as above described - Including his Improvement which consists of a frame house with a family residing therein three acres cleared land, on the East end a young orchard & seven acres cleared on the west end of the tract.

Note: A warrant was granted on the 22d August 1814 to John Pfortz & Michael Crane for part of the East end of this tract which if executed agreeably to its location would include part of the cleared land. Antises Improvement being a good one and made in Sept. 1811 (as appears by his warrant) I executed his warrant in preference to Pfortz & Crane.
