Note. An order of survey was granted to Jeremiah Gervin for 100<sup>ac</sup> "joining  
Samuel Barberton and Samuel Perry, between the Albertiny Mountain & North  
Mountain in Fannet Township dated 25. March 1767 No 3207 seems to locate a part of  
the above land but no evidence of any claimant under the same in the land being claimed  
on the order to Johnston as above stated - Although Johnston's order would locate land further  
southward. - James Paddle Esq; owner. - David & George Riddle, occupants
