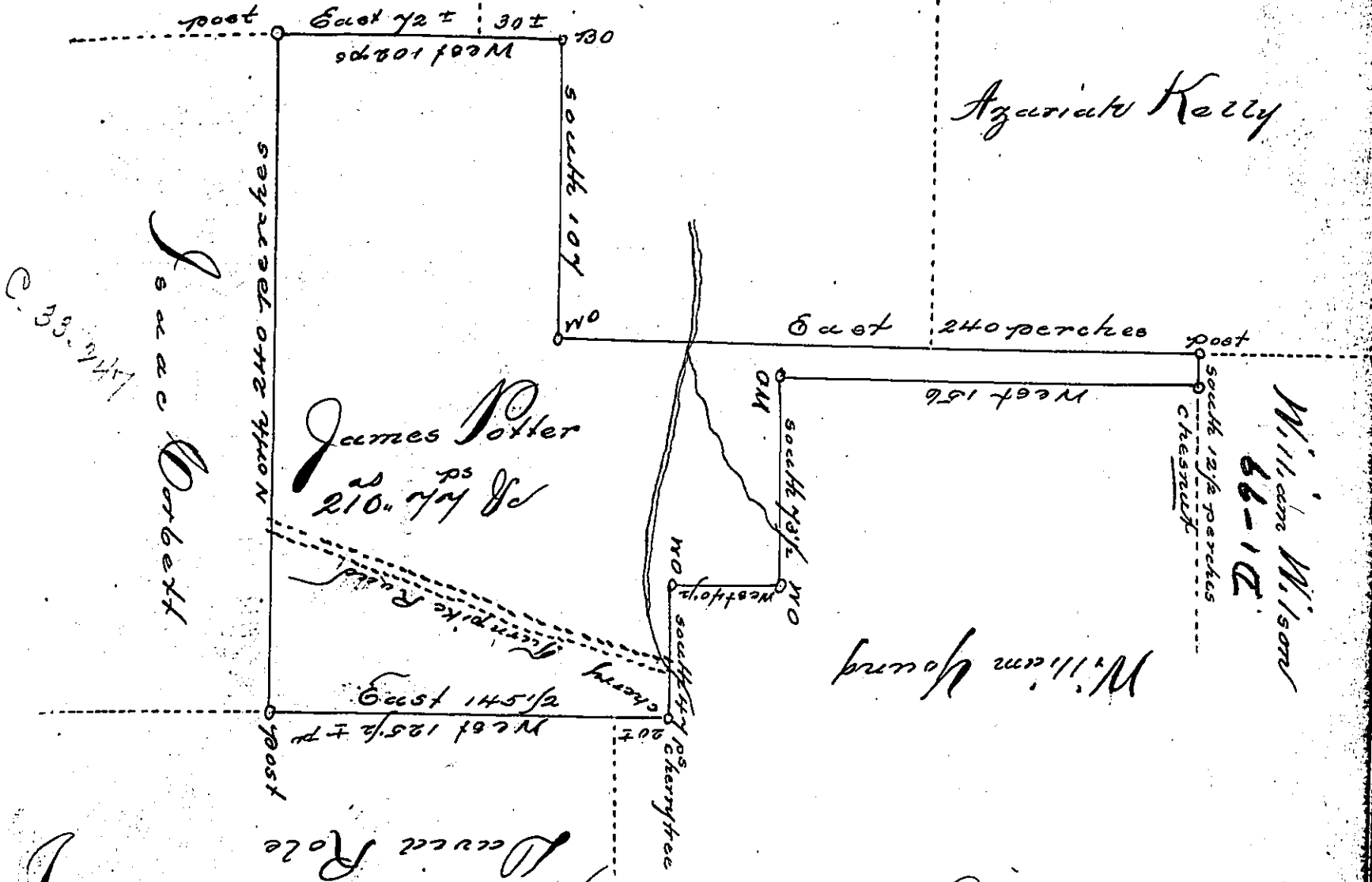


Lands of Bair and Company
