



A Draught of a Tract of Land called the Chest Farm being part of a larger Tract of the same name situate on the South or principal head Branch of Chest Creek about half a Mile below a place known by the name of the Beaver Dams on the said Branch about five or six miles above where the old Trading Path from Frankstown to the Kittanning crosses the said Creek adjoining Land surveyed for John Elmsley Samuel Rhoads Richard Porter & Lands surveyed on behalf of Samuel Pleasant in the County of Bedford containing three hundred and twenty four acres and thirty seven Perches and the usual Allowance of six Per Cent. for Roads &c. surveyed the 17<sup>th</sup> Day of June 1773 for Jabez Maud Fisher in pursuance of a Warrant granted to him Dated the 27<sup>th</sup> Day of April in the same year by John Lukens Esq<sup>r</sup> Surveyor } Thomas Smith D.S. General of Pennsylvania -
