



By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 12<sup>th</sup> December 1792 No. 2373 there was surveyed the 16<sup>th</sup> of August 1794 by W<sup>m</sup> P. Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor) to Wilhem Willink, Nicholas Vanstaphorst Christian Van Seghen, Hendrick Wollenhouer, and Rutger Jan Schimmel penninck the above described Tract of nine hundred & twenty six 1/4 acres & allowance situate on the Waters of Little Mahoning in District No. 5 in last Purchase in the County of Lycoming - a Copy of which remains in my Office.
