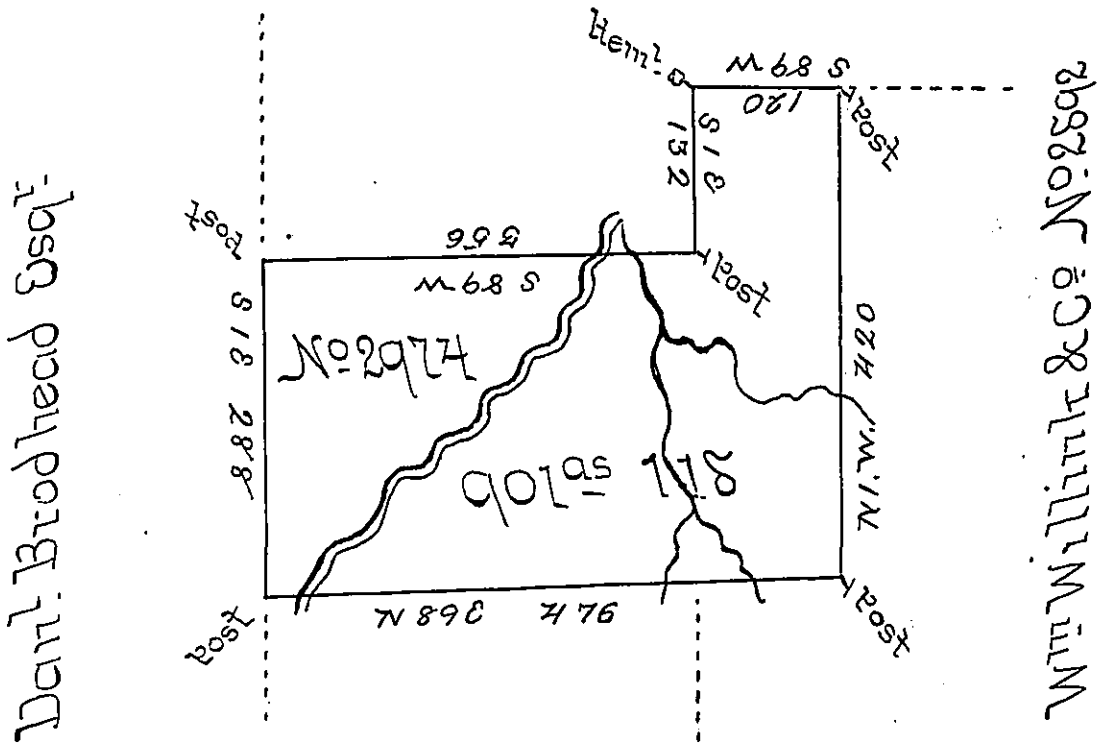

By Virtue of a Warrant dated the 13th December 1792 No 2974, there was surveyed the 25th August 1794 by Wm E. Brady (the former Deputy Surveyor to ^{Say Wilhem} Willink Nicholas Staphorst, Christian Van Egan, Hendrick Vollenhoven & Ridger Jan Schimmelpinnick, the above described Tract of Nine hundred one acres & one hundred & eighteen perches and allowance situate on the Waters of Little Mahoning in District No 5 in the late purchase in the County of Wyoming, a Copy of which remains in my Office
