



Draft of a tract of land surveyed for Benjamin Mead the 12th day of January A. D. 1838 situate in Conewa (661) township Warren County and North and West of the Allegheny Ri (661) and Conewango Creek containing Three Hundred twenty one acres and one hundred fifty six perches and allowance.

Note: The above described lot of land was included in a survey made the 28th day of October 1819 by John Irvine Esqr. then Deputy Surveyor of Warren County for Edmund Green on improvement and settlement and is now claimed by Benjamin Mead.
