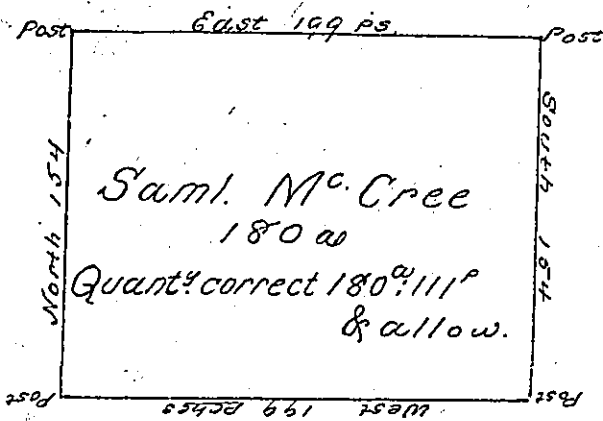

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 17th day of January 1733, Survey'd to Samuel Mc Cree a Tract of land in Calm in the County of Chester, Beginning at a post at a corner of Thomas Eldridges land thence east by the same 199 pches to a post thence south 154 pches to a post thence west 199 pches to a post thence north by the sd. Eldridges land 154 pches to the place of Beginning Containing one Hundred & Eighty ~~four~~ acres and the usual allowance for roads.

Another Warrt to Return this land to Jno. Culbertson dated the 5th of ~~Decr~~ ^{Decr} 1739.
